



Next week, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) will hold a public hearing to discuss the final design phase of a key infrastructure project - a pedestrian overpass at the intersection of **Sand Lake Road and International Drive**. The meeting will take place at **2:00 PM (or shortly thereafter)** on **Tuesday, June 17, 2025** at the **Orange County Commission Chambers**, 201 S. Rosalind Ave., Orlando, FL 32801.

This integral infrastructure project aims to enhance **pedestrian safety** while creating a visually impactful **gateway to one of Orange County's busiest tourism corridors**.
