

Engineers' Council Dedicates Building at Dream Village



CFHLA congratulates our Engineers' Council and many other partners who dedicated a new storage building Thursday to help the **Sunshine Foundation Dream Village** in Davenport, Florida. The Sunshine Foundation is a local nonprofit group that serves children with disabilities and their families.

The Council donated the permanent metal building at Dream Village, because the storage sheds there are badly deteriorating. The \$23,000 project will enable the Sunshine Foundation team to store files, holiday decorations, landscaping and maintenance equipment, as well as other gear they use every day to carry out their compassionate mission.

The Sunshine Foundation Dream Village grants Special Dreams to families of children who have profound physical, developmental or intellectual challenges or trauma from physical abuse. The Village offers these families a place to stay in fairy tale-themed cottages while they enjoy Dream Trips to Central Florida's theme parks and other attractions.

The CFHLA Engineers' Council agreed several years ago to replace the damaged storage sheds, but the 2020 Pandemic knocked the project off course. Volunteers are thrilled

they were able to persevere and complete the project to assist the nonprofit's compassionate mission.

The Council and its partners made repairs to the Dream Village playground and mini golf course three years ago. They also installed the village's new entrance sign this past summer.


