Welcome Lance Lyttle, New CEO of GOAA



This week, the <u>Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA)</u> Board of Directors selected <u>Lance Lyttle</u> to serve as the next <u>Chief Executive</u> Officer, overseeing <u>Orlando International Airport (MCO)</u> and the <u>Orlando Executive Airport (ORL)</u>.

With Orlando International now in the nation's Top 10 airports and passenger volume exceeding 57 million annually, Mr. Lyttle will oversee this vital transportation hub that is an economic engine at the heart of the region. He will also be responsible for leading a multi-billion-dollar capital improvement program to enhance both airports.

Currently, Mr. Lyttle is the Managing Director of Aviation for Seattle-Tacoma Airport. With more than 25 years of aviation experience, he began his career at Hartsfield Jackson International Airport as the Chief Information Officer. He was then appointed Chief Strategy and Performance Officer for the Houston Airport System before moving through the ranks to Chief Development Officer and Chief Operating Officer.

Last December, the GOAA Board launched a search for a new CEO after current CEO Kevin J. Thibault announced his resignation due to a family illness. Mr. Lyttle will assume the role in April 2025, pending contract negotiations, succeeding **Kevin J. Thibault**.
