Today, CFHLA was proud to be the host sponsor once again, for the 2025 State of Orange County Address presented by Orange County Mayor Jerry L. Demings.

Thank you to all of the sponsors, CFHLA Members and elected officials who joined us this morning at the **Orange County Convention Center**, as well as those who joined us virtually on Orange TV's streaming broadcast.

During the address, we were thrilled to hear the positive news that the Central Florida hospitality and tourism industry drew 75.3 million visitors last year and generated a record \$92.5 billion in economic impact. This is in addition to the nearly 464,000 local jobs that are now supported by the industry. Furthermore, Mayor Demings shared an overview of the accomplishments that we've faced here in Orange County, as well as provided a shared vision on how we are "building better through efficiency."

Lastly, Mayor Demings addressed several other community priorities, including the proper investment into transportation and infrastructure, the continued support of our tourism and hospitality industry, public safety, workforce housing and more.

Universal Epic Universe's Community-Wide Impact

The wait is over - Universal Epic Universe at Universal Orlando Resort is now officially open!

Epic Universe is the company's most ambitious endeavor to date, and it represents more than just a new theme park – it's a continued investment in the future of our Central Florida community through job creation, business growth, tourism development and more.



This includes:

- Comcast's direct investment in Epic Universe has resulted in \$11B of economic impact nationwide.
- Epic Universe is anticipated to generate \$2B for the state of Florida, in its first year of operations.
- 65,000 jobs were generated across the country by Epic Universe construction.
- Epic Universe is projected to create more than 17,500 new jobs across the country in its first year of operations.
- The addition of 2,000 new hotel rooms within the Epic Universe resort complex and nearby properties are expected to generate \$13M in Tourist Development Tax revenue from increased tourism volume.
- Since the program's inception in 1998, Universal Orlando team member volunteers have donated more than 600,000 hours of service.
- From 2019 2023, Universal Orlando Foundation grants, Universal Orlando cash donations, and in-kind contributions totaled \$69.6M.
